They are being utilized for diagnosis and targeting cancer, for improving properties of problematic drugs and also for delivery of biological cells and biotechnological products. This instrument has made it possible for both UG and PG students to take up projects on cutting-edge drug delivery strategies involving nanocarriers like polymeric nanoparticles, nanostructured lipid carriers, nanovesicles, nanoemulsion etc.
10. Academic Application of the Equipment Procured, if any: Equipment is in use for separation of nanostructured lipid carriers loaded with clobetasol for the treatment of psoriasis and nanovesicles loaded with an antifungal drug loaded for nail infection.
