

What does not fall under plagiarism?

- Using common knowledge and basic facts...
  - · Saving or clichés
  - Facts that are assumed to be known by readers (this depends on audience!)
  - · Easily verified facts
- ...but not all facts are common knowledge:
- · Facts that surprise you or the reader
- · Course-specific knowledge
- · Facts that include statistics or numbers
- $\bullet$  Using quotes, even if its content is common knowledge.

## Deliberate or accidental Plagiarism

- Copying content (without paraphrasing and/or attribution)
- Submitting a paper that was not written by the person submitting it.
- Copying content (but not remembering its original source)
- Not citing properly
- Improper paraphrasing
- Not distinguishing common knowledge

PROPER PARAPHRASING:

- Read carefully through what you intend to paraphrase,
- then rewrite the idea in your own words without using the original work as a guide.
- Also, check your paraphrase against the original text to be sure you have not unintentionally used the same phrases or words, and that the information is correct.

The participants were made aware of various methods to avoid plagiarism. Also, the participants learnt various writing and citation tools to reduce the plagiarism that students normally make during their scientific writing. There is a strong need for the students to understand the disadvantages of plagiarism, and how it reduces their credibility in scientific content writing. Under the ISTE students' chapter various events considering the overall development of students is targeted. Around 54 students were present for the online session.
