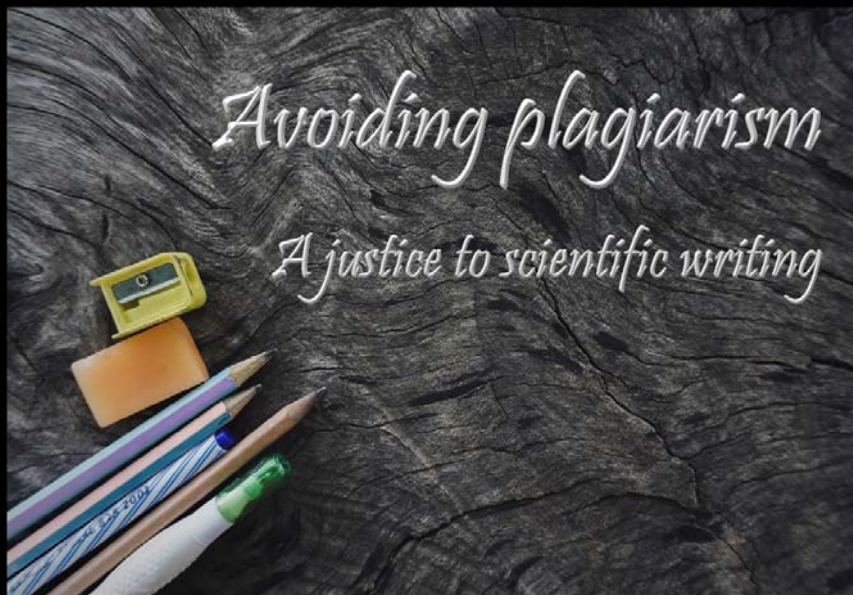

What does not fall under plagiarism?

- Using common knowledge and basic facts...
 - Saying or clichés
 - Facts that are assumed to be known by readers (this depends on audience!)
 - Easily verified facts

...but not all facts are common knowledge:

- Facts that surprise you or the reader
- Course-specific knowledge
- Facts that include statistics or numbers
- Using quotes, even if its content is common knowledge.

Deliberate or accidental Plagiarism

- Copying content (without paraphrasing and/or attribution)
- Submitting a paper that was not written by the person submitting it.
- Copying content (but not remembering its original source)
- Not citing properly
- Improper paraphrasing
- Not distinguishing common knowledge



Under the ISTE students' chapter various events considering the overall development of students is targeted. Around 54 students were present for the online session. The session was concluded with question and answer session, and filling and submission of the online feedback form.
