मा. कुलगुरू व अध्यक्ष रासेयो राष्ट्रसंत तुकडोजी महाराज नागपूर विद्यापीठ यांच्या निर्देशानुसार २०२०-२१ चा शैक्षणिक सत्राकरिता आपल्या महाविद्यालयास रासेयो विभागासाठी १ पथक मंजूर करण्यात आले असून त्यात १०० विद्यार्थी / विद्यार्थिनी सहभागी होऊ शकतात नोंदणी करताना हे प्रमाण ७:३ असावे. नोंदणीकृत विद्यार्थ्यांची यादी रासेयो कार्यालयास लगेच सादर करावी. विद्यापीठ रासेयो कक्षाकडे पाठविण्यात आलेल्या यादीत बदल करणे शक्य होणार नाही.

१) अनुदान : राज्य संपर्क अधिकारी, रासेयोउपचर व तंत्र शिक्षणविभाग महापद राज्य यांचे कटून आलेल्या प्रभागानुसार रासेयो चे कार्यक्रम राबविण्यासाठी अनुदान निर्धारित करण्यात येईल.

अ) निवडणुकाकार्यक्रम : निवडणुका कार्यक्रमाच्या आयोजनासाठी प्रति विद्यार्थी प्रति वर्ष २५० प्रमाणे अनुदान अनुज्ञेय आहे. ह्या अनुदाना वर विद्यापीठस्तरावर खालील प्रमाणे कपात करून अनुदान देण्यात येईल.

आ) वार्षिक शुल्क-रासेयो मध्ये प्रवेशित विद्यार्थ्यांकडून वार्षिक ₹.१०/- नोंदणी शुल्क देण्यात यावे. आपल्या महाविद्यालयास अनुज्ञेय असल्याच्या नियमित कार्यक्रमाच्या अनुदान राशीतून हा प्रभाग समाप्तीत करण्यात येईल.

२) विशेष शिबीर कार्यक्रम : सात दिवसीय विशेष शिबीर कार्यक्रमाच्या आधोजनासाठी आपल्या महाविद्यालयास मंजूर विद्यार्थी संख्येच्या ५० टक्के विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी प्रति विद्यार्थी ₹.२५०/- प्रमाणे अनुदान अनुज्ञेय आहे.

खालील कार्याधीपूर्ती झाल्यानंतरच अनुदानाचा प्रथम प्रभाग शिबीर प्रस्तावांचा मंजुरी प्रदान करण्यात येईल.

अ) शैक्षणिक सत्राकरिता नोंदविण्यात आलेल्या विद्यार्थ्यांची प्रवर्ग विहाय तसेच सर्व विद्यार्थ्यांचे प्रोव्हाईल नंबर व ई-मेलआय डीसह यादी पाठविणे आवश्यक आहे. यात अनुसूचित जाती १७ टक्के व अनुसूचित जमाती ७ टक्के शिक्षा जास्त असणे अनिवार्य आहे.

ब) विशेष शिबीरचे प्रस्ताव दिनांक ३१ ऑक्टोबर २०१९ पर्यंत रासेयो कार्यालयात सादर करणे अनिवार्य आहे.

क) प्रत्येक महाविद्यालयास रासेयोच्या नावे कार्यक्रम अधिकारी व प्राचार्य यांच्या संयुक्त स्वाक्षरीने राष्ट्रीयकृत बँकेत स्वतंत्र खाते असणे अनिवार्य आहे. तसेच या रासेयो खात्याचे PFMS नोंदणी रासेयो कार्यालयाच्यावतीने करणे अनिवार्य आहे. बऱ्याच महाविद्यालयाची नोंदणी झालेली आहे. ज्यांची नोंदणी झालेली नाही त्यांनी रासेयो कार्यालयात येऊन नोंदणी करून घ्यावी सोबत पासबुक किंवा cancel चेकची प्रत आणावी. ज्या महाविद्यालयाची नोंदणी झालेली आहे परंतु त्यांच्या जवळ पुनिक कोड व पासवर्ड नसेल त्यांनी प्राचार्यांच्या नावे पत्राद्वारे प्राप्न करून घ्यावे.

ड) रासेयोचे अंकेक्षण विवरण १५ एप्रिल २०२१ पर्यंत रासेयो कार्यालयात सादर करणे अनिवार्य आहे.

च) प्रत्येक पथकासाठी स्वतंत्र कार्यक्रम अधिकाऱ्याची नियुक्ती, त्याचे नाव, परचा परत महाविद्यालय किंवा निवासस्थानी असलेला दुरध्वनी क्रमांक आणि धपणध्वनी क्रमांक इत्यादी माहिती लगेच रासेयो कार्यालयास सादर करावी.

छ) कार्यक्रम अधिकाऱ्याचे प्रशिक्षण झाले नसल्यास त्यांना TORC अहमदनगर येथे त्वरीत पाठविणे अनिवार्य आहे. प्रशिक्षणाचे रोड्युल रासेयो कार्यालयातून प्राप्त करत येईल. रैमासिक, अर्धवार्षिक अहवाल वेळेच्या आत पाठवणे बंधनकारक आहे.

ज) सत्र २०१९-२० ह्या कालावधीतील अंकेधित विवरण (नियमित व विशेष शिबीर कार्यक्रम आणि वार्षिक अहवाल प्रलंबित असल्यास सात दिवसांचे आत त्वरीत सादर करावे) कृपया नोंद घ्यावी ही विनंती.

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UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN (UBA)

The conceptualization of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan started with the initiative of a group of dedicated faculty members of Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Delhi working for long in the area of rural development and appropriate technology. The concept was nurtured through wide consultation with the representatives of a number of technical institutions, Rural Technology Action Group (RuTAG) coordinators, voluntary organizations and government agencies, actively involved in rural development work, during a National workshop held at IIT Delhi in September, 2014. The workshop was sponsored by Council for Advancement of People's Action and Rural Technology (CAPART), Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India. The program was formally launched by the Ministry of Education (MoE) (formerly Ministry Human Resource Development (MHRD)) in presence of the President of India on 11th November, 2014.

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is inspired by the vision of transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help build the architecture of an Inclusive India. The Mission of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is to enable higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate solutions for accelerating sustainable growth. It also aims to create a virtuous cycle between society and an inclusive academic system by providing knowledge and practices



for emerging professions and to upgrade the capabilities of both the public and the private sectors in responding to the development needs of rural India.

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), a flagship programme of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Govt. of India. Higher educational institutions (HEIs) of the country adopt villages for their development. Faculty and students to be involved in village development plan in collaboration with district administration. Institute of Pharmaceutical Education & Research, Borgaon(Meghe), Wardha participated in UBA and adopted 5 villages [Borgaon, Warud, Nalwadi, Inzapur, Sawangi(Meghe)] for their development in collaboration with district administration. Institute, UBA cell invited all faculty and students to join UBA to bring for transformational change in the villages. The UBA cell of the Institute successfully completed the village survey and household survey activity in adopted villages. The 277 students of the institute participated in Unnat Bharat Abhiyan.
