

1. Title of the practice:

Health awareness programme

2. Goals:

- 1.To raise awareness among students and the general public in rural areas regarding a variety of health and wellness-related topics.
- 2. To instill a sense of personal responsibility for one's health among students and the general public in rural areas.
- 3. To encourage students and the general population in rural areas to develop healthy habits.
- 4. To present a range of health concerns and explain their significance in everyday life.

3. The Context:

The majority of our college students come from extremely rural locations. The rural populace and those students are ignorant of nutrition and health. As a result, keeping an eye on students' health has grown more crucial. People in rural areas have a low level of health awareness. As a result, raising health awareness among college students and those living in rural areas is crucial. It would be possible to raise students' awareness of healthy eating habits and health consciousness if we created an interactive health awareness program.

4. The Practice:

The following actions have been performed on campus to support the worthy goals of health awareness program:

- 1. Blood donation and health checkup camp programs: The institution frequently organizes free blood donation and health exam camps to raise awareness and foster a healthy environment.
- 2. On June 5, 2024, the Institute held a quiz contest in observance of World Environment Day

- 3. On June 21, 2023, the Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Borgaon (Megh
- e), Wardha's National Service Scheme (NSS) unit observed International Yoga Day from 4:0 0 to 5:30 p.m.
- 4. On September 23, outside the college grounds, the Institute of Pharmaceutical Education a nd Wardha's National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit held a "Tree Plantation" program.
- 5. On September 27, the Institute of Pharmaceutical Education Wardha's National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit hosted Eco-Friedly Ganesh Visarjan.
- 6. In collaboration with Vaidyakiya Janjagruti Manch Wardha, the Institute of Pharmaceutica l Education Wardha's National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit held an Aids Awareness Rally in rural areas on December 1, 2023.
- 7. On December 6, 2023, the Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Wardha's National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit hosted an online session called the "NB EMS CPR Awareness Program" at room 121 on the college's campus.
- 8. On May 6, 2024, the Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Wardha's National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit held "Awareness programs on Vitamin D and Vitamin B12" in Borgaon (Meghe), Wardha.

5. Evidence of success:

- 1. The NSS unit of the institute, in collaboration with the Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences, Sawangi (Meghe), Wardha, held a blood donation camp where around 36 students donated blood. On February 23, 2024, IPER held a medical examination camp. About 222 girls and 112 boys in the B. Pharm and M. Pharm courses were examined by medical officers.
- 2. A total of 97 students took part in the quiz contest. Students took part in a program that planted trees.
- 3. In collaboration with the Patanjali Yoga Centre in Wardha, a yoga camp was held at the institute. Patanjali demonstrated the various yoga positions for Mrs. Pranita tai Ghulane and Mrs. Meena tai Dhole. Seventy-four B. Pharm and M. Pharm students, as well as faculty and staff from the institute, attended the camp.
- 4. On September 23, 46 B. Pharm and M. Pharm students took part in the "Tree Plantation" event off campus.
- 5. The Eco-friendly Ganesh Visargen program involved 102 B. Pharm and M. Pharm students as well as teaching staff.
- 6. 264 B. Pharm students and faculty members took part in the AIDS awareness program.
- 7. 49 B. Pharm and M. Pharm students participated in the NB EMS CPR Awareness Program.

8. Forty-two residents of Borgaon village took part in vitamin D and vitamin B12 awareness workshops.
