Best Practice 1:

1. Title of the practice:

Initiative for environment awareness and sustainability at IPER

2. Goals:

- a. To provide environmental literacy to motivate students, teachers and supporting staff.
- b. To Introduce students to nature so they can learn to develop sensitivity, awareness and respect for the environment.
- c. To acquire a set of principles for preserving the environment.
- d. To give people the chance to actively participate in environmental decision-making at all levels.

3. The Context:

The current global climate problem forces the institution to view environmental consciousness as its top priority. It also requires the institution to create high criteria for environmental friendliness and to recognise and commend practises that continue to organise and work at the forefront of environmental innovation. Through environmental policy advocacy, promoting environmental awareness, and encouraging local participation in conservation efforts to lessen the threat, the college believes it is its primary duty to make society aware of the deteriorating environmental parameters and to prod them to adopt eco-friendly ways.

4. The Practice:

The following actions have been performed on campus to support the worthy goals of environmental awareness and sustainability:

1. The college has introduced various energy saving methods. LED lighting is used in many places in the campus. A solar energy system is installed in the campus with a

real capacity of 9 kW. Sensor based energy saving is installed in the institute. This is a very encouraging step towards access to renewable, inexhaustible and clean energy sources.

- 2. The Institute's NSS Division organized a quiz competition to coincide with World Environment Day on 5 June 2022. 90 students participated in the quiz competition.
- 3. The institute organized a tree planting campaign on 01 october 2022, which was attended by 45 students on the college ground.
- 4. For Earth Day (April 22, 2023), the Institute has organized a tree planting program on April 24, 2023. Since April 22nd and 23rd are holidays, the tree planting ceremony was held on April 24th, 2023.

5. Evidence of success:

- a. Use of renewable and sustainable energy sources such as LED lamps on campus.
- b. Generating green power through the use of solar modules enhances the use of conventional power generation.
- c. Encourage students and teachers to save electricity, save paper, save money

6. Problems encountered and resources required:

1. Title of the practice:

2. Goals:

3. The Context:

4. The Practice:

- On March 13, 2023, two of our alumni—Mr. Pratik Gajananrao Deshmukh, the area sales manager for Sun Pharma in Nagpur, and Mr. Balu Sahebrao Chaudhari, the

business officer for Zydus Healthcare in Wardha gave guest lectures on the subject of "job selection and interview preparation."
