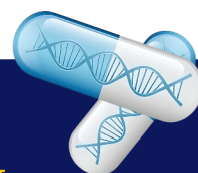

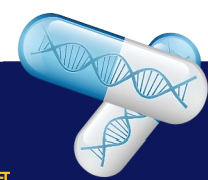

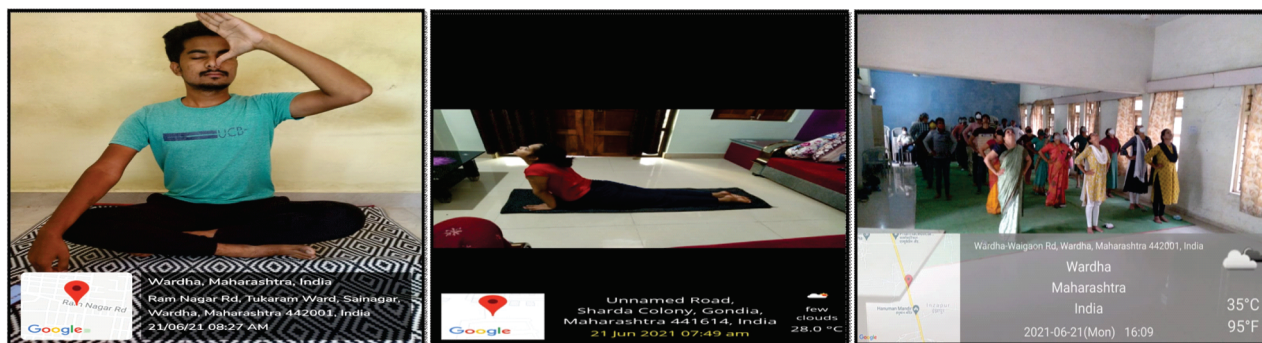

2. June 21, Yoga Day Online (Students) and offline (Staff)

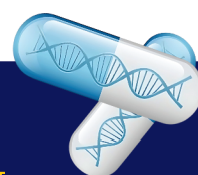

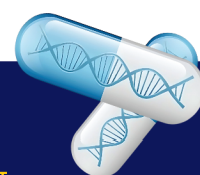
4. July 28, Tree Plantation Programme

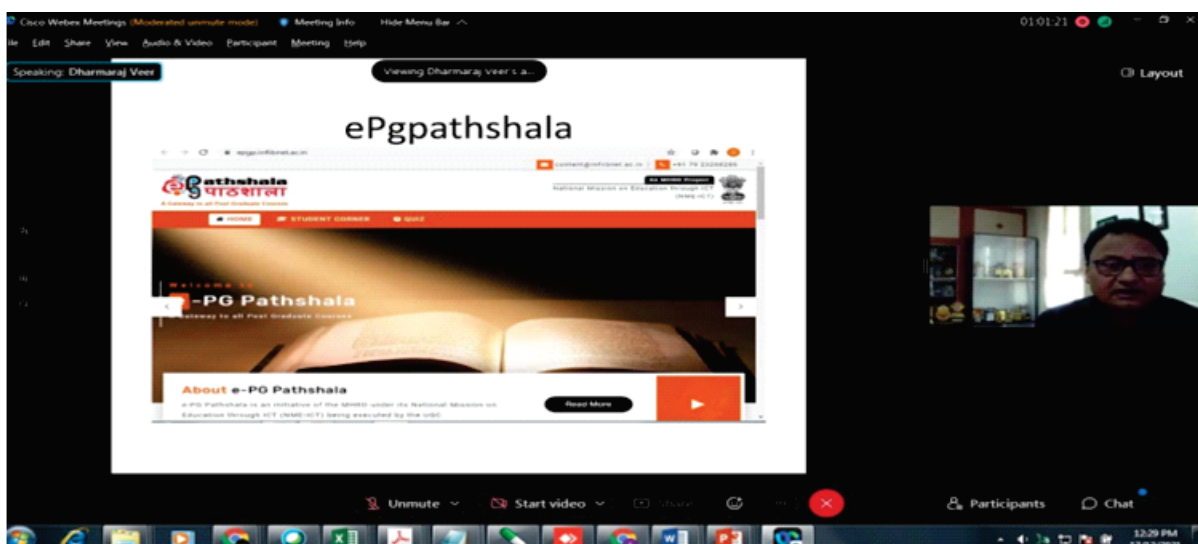
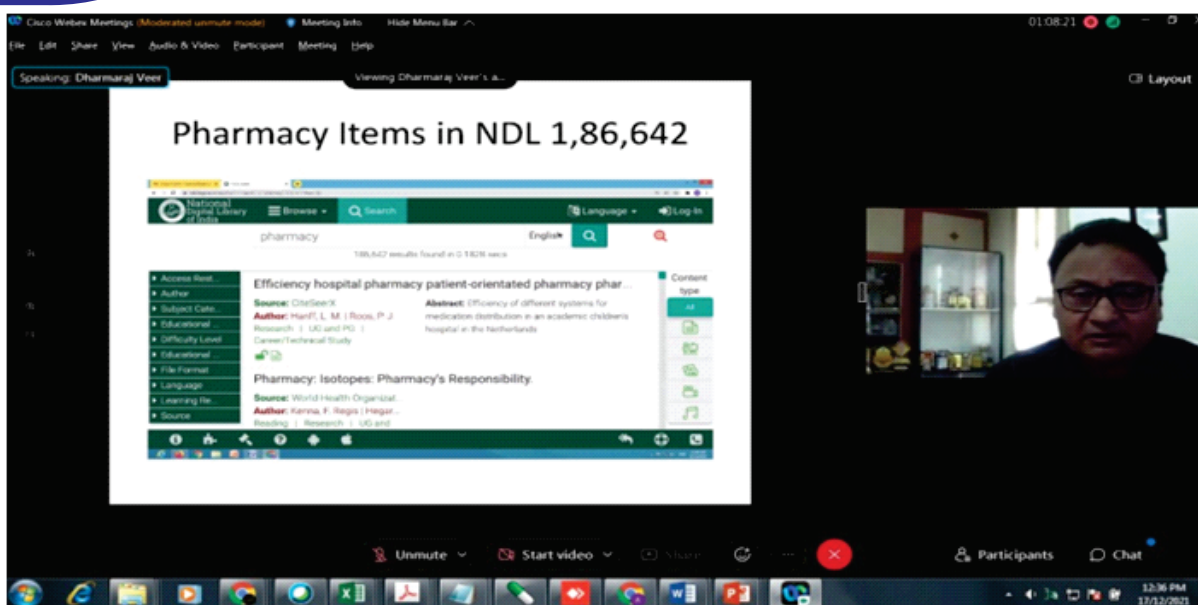

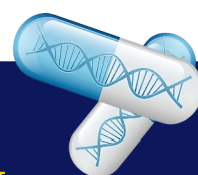


6. July 24 to 28, Five Day Workshop cum Administrative Training Programme for non-teaching staff

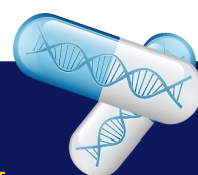
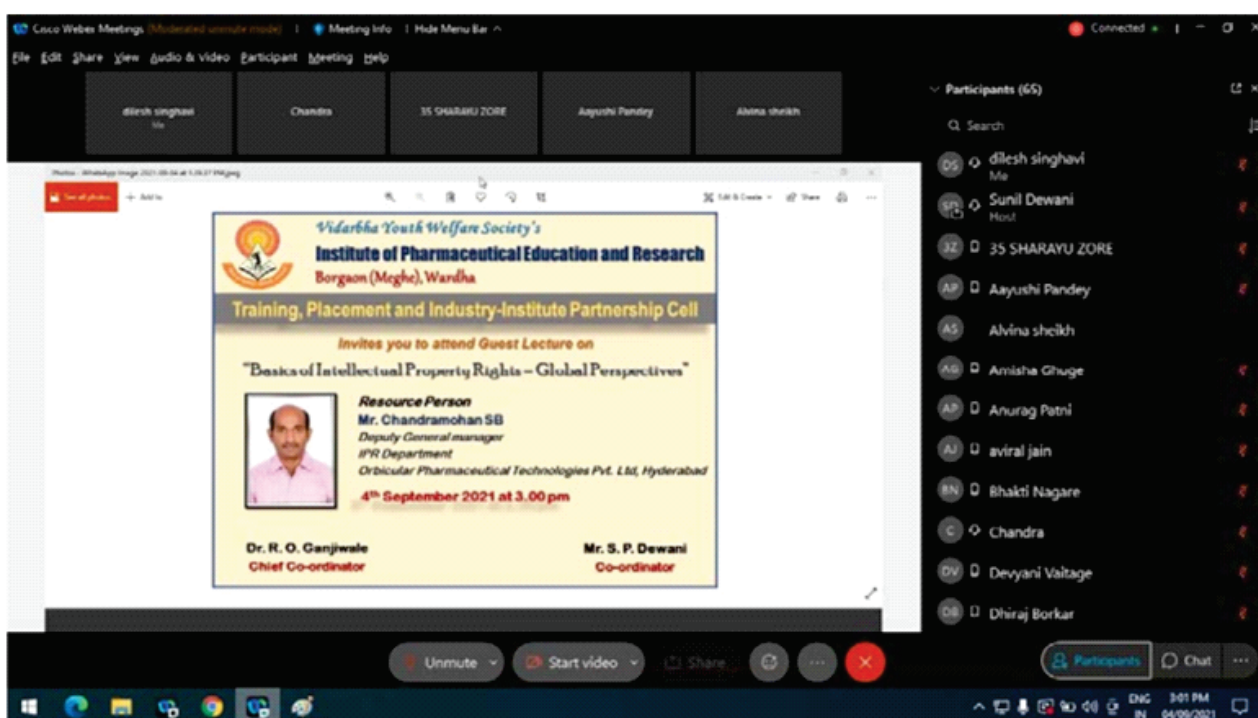
8. September 2, Tree Plantation Programme under "Mazi Vasundhara Abhiyan"

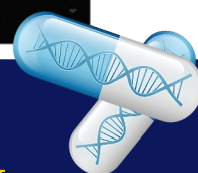
10. September 11th, Webinar on topic "Application of Computational Chemistry in Drug Design"

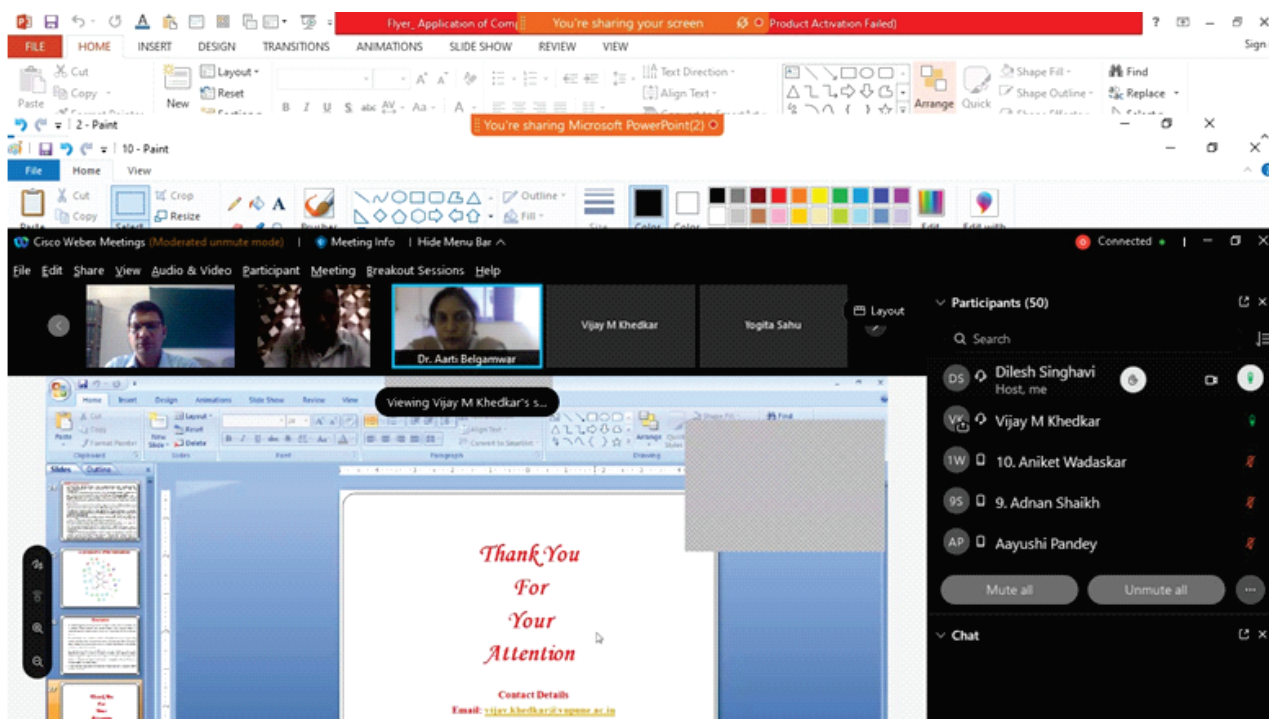
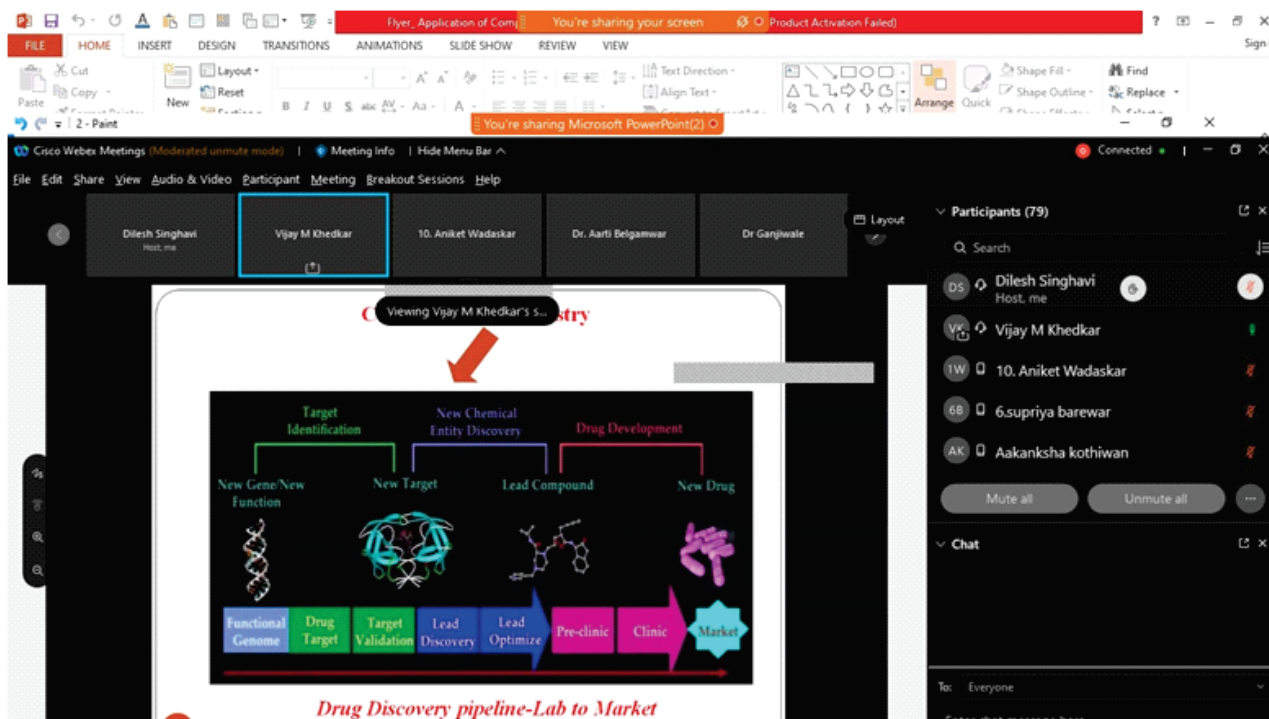

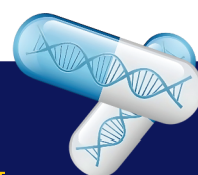


11. September 15th Seminar (offline) on Topic- 'National Innovation and startup policy' under Institute Innovation Council

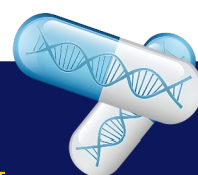
Dr. R. O. Ganjiwale (I/c Principal),gave introductory speech, they highlighted about importance and objectives of "Institution's Innovation council".

September 25, Webinar under the banner of Gender sensitization cell and Women security Cell.

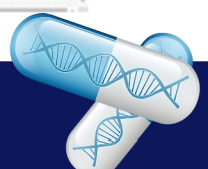
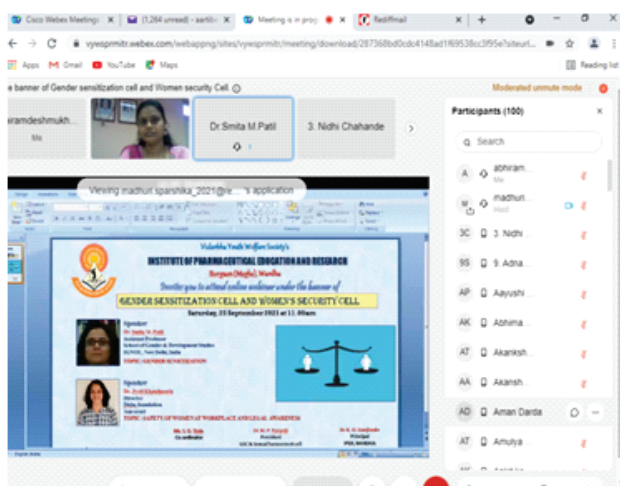

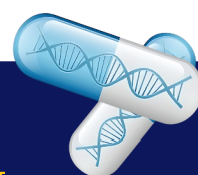
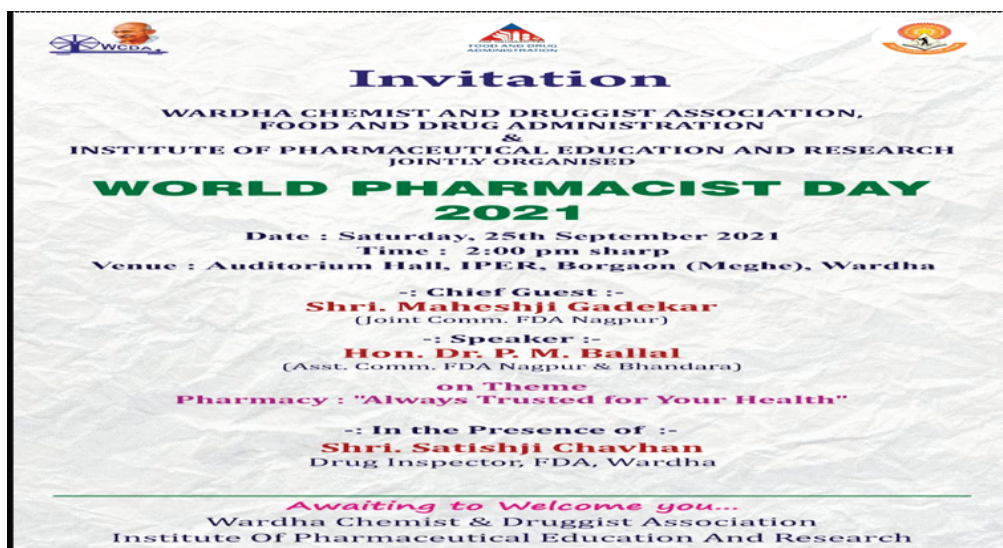




15. World Pharmacist Day celebration in association with Food and Drug Administration and Wardha Chemist and Druggist Association

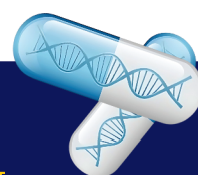
16. Campus Pool Interview

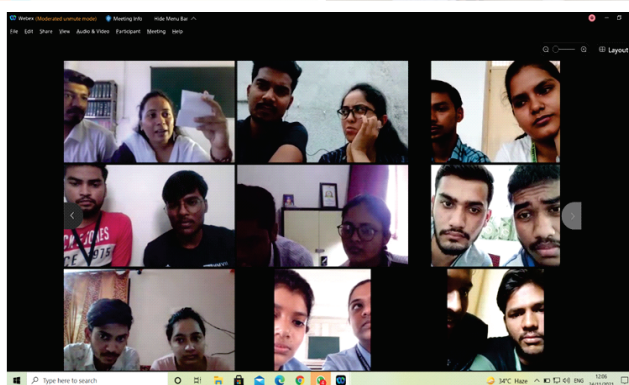
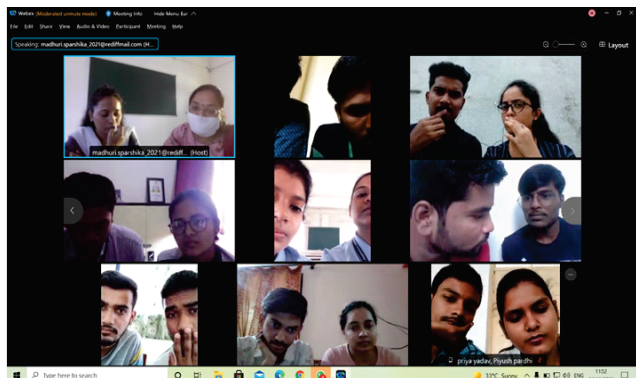


17. November 24, Intercollegiate Quiz Competition on the occasion of National Pharmacy Week

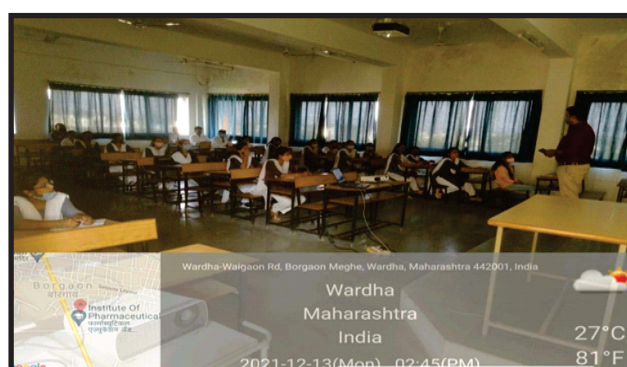


21. December 7, Online Quiz on occasion of Competition Mahaparivran Din

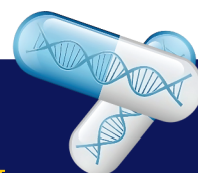


24. Seminar on Topic "Healthy relationship with opposite genders"

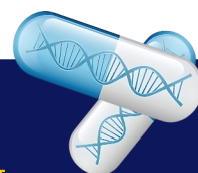
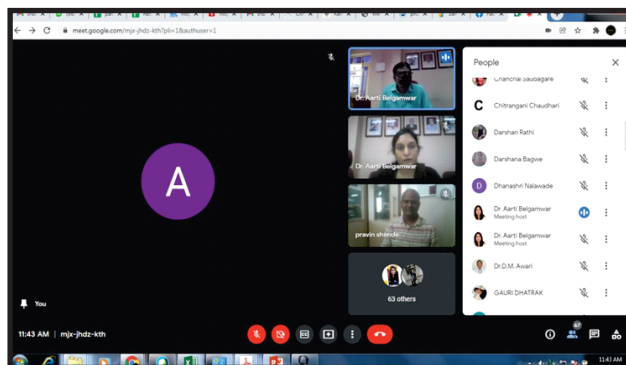
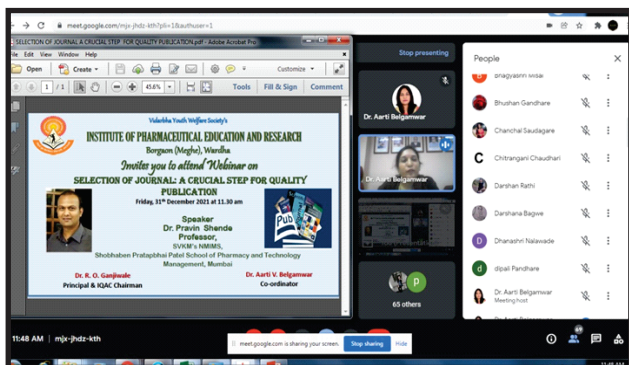


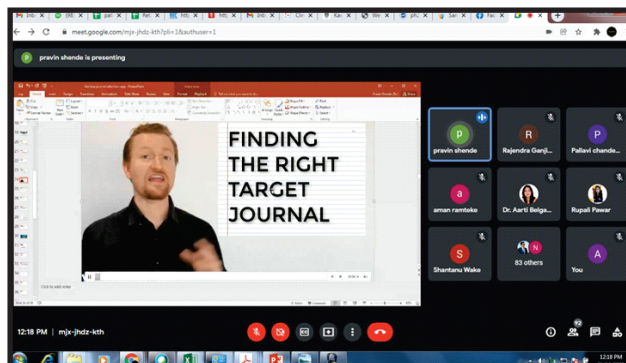
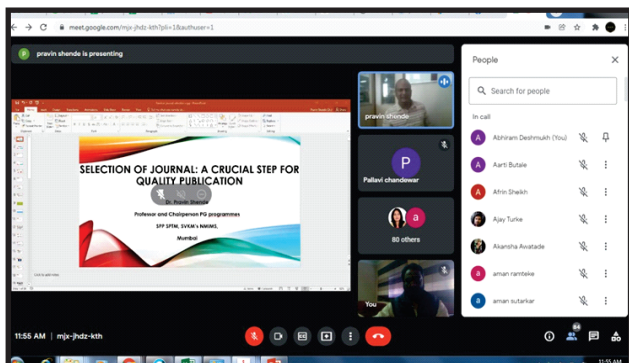


25. December 31st, Webinar on "SELECTION OF JOURNAL: A CRUCIAL STEP FOR QUALITY PUBLICATION"

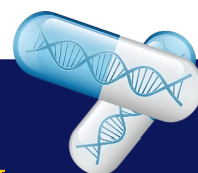
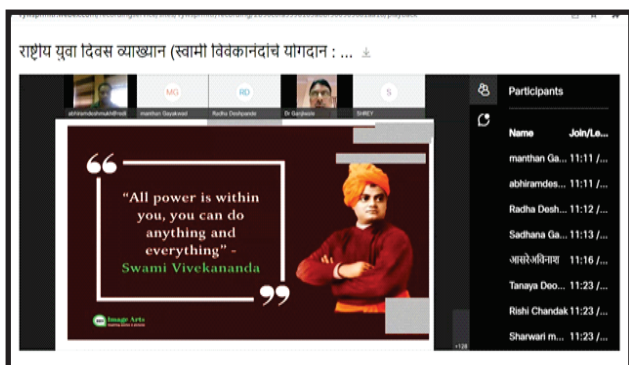
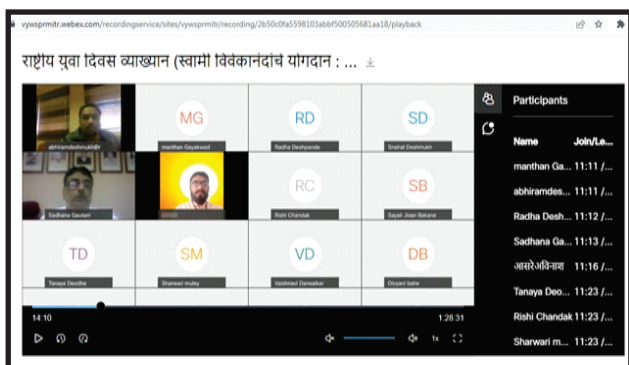


26. January 12 th National Youth Day Celebration
