# POSTER COMPETITION ON TOPIC “AWARENESS ON SCRUB TYPHUS”

Scrub typhus is a mite-borne infection caused by *Orientia tsutsugamushi*. The disease is transmitted to humans through the bites of larvae of different species of trombiculid mites, appearing commonly in the autumn season. Rodents provide a disease reservoir whereas mites act as a reservoir and a disease vector. Clinical features at presentation range from non-specific flu-like symptoms such as fever, rash, an eschar at the bite site, headache, myalgia, and cough to severe systemic, life-threatening conditions involving the lungs, heart, liver, skin, central nervous system, and gastrointestinal tract. Furthermore, it has been reported that inappropriately or untreated scrub typhus has a mortality rate of at least 30%. The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Bargaon(Meghe), Wardha organized Poster competition on topic “Awareness on Scrub Typhus” was organized on 25th September 2018.
